- **We must each guard our hearts, our words and our attitudes.**

- **Will there be ministry to our body on Sunday?**
 - ✓ Yes! In one form or another we are working to livestream worship and our message on Sunday, providing for the preaching of the word and ministry to others in homes, cars or at the park, if people choose.
 - ✓ This is new for us and we ask for patience as we try to
- **How do I give my tithe and offerings? There are several ways:**
 - ✓ You may mail it to Victory Rd A/G, 200 Victory Rd, Norfolk, NE 68701, noting where you desire your gift to go on the check or in a note.
 - ✓ You may stop by, seal it in a giving envelope and then into the offering box in the foyer, or bring it to the office.
 - ✓ You may give online...and this is perhaps the easiest way in these days. Echecks are available on our site (vrag.generush.org) as well as credit/debit card giving. Once you set up your account, you pay it like any other online payment. No funds will be taken from your account until you authorize it. You may also designate it to be a recurring payment, but we encourage individual, intentional transactions. There is no cost to you or the church to use echecks. - **Will the church be available for prayer or Bible study with others as long as the group is 10 or less?**
 - ✓ Yes, the church and office will be open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday – Friday; Sunday 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.
- **Will we have ministry to the children?**
 - ✓ Pastor Amy is developing a plan to provide ministry though 3D Kids. It will be during the week, limited to 10 children from 5 yrs – 6th Grade. It will be held over two or three days.
This plan is not final at this time, but it should be in place before next week.
 - ✓ We have decided to not try and do streaming video due to the technical aspects of providing effective, excellent interactive ministry to children.
- **How can I know what the church is doing day to day?**
 - ✓ Check our website victoryroad.org and Facebook. We are working to keep these current.
- **We plan to continue our weekly services and ministry, but are going to have to move to something more creative than we have ever done. Please bear with us as we develop ways to stay connected as a Body of believers.**
