## **ASSISTANT PASTOR – CHILDREN & FAMILY FOCUS**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

This position will start as a part-time position; good jobs are relatively easy to obtain in our community. Our school system is excellent and we have open doors to substitute teaching and para-teaching opportunities, as well as many skilled technical and professional opportunities. We have an active children's ministry. Our schools and community are very open to our involvement. Our current Family/Children's pastor is moving to a church plant in a nearby community.

### **JOB FUNCTION**

To provide Christ-focused, Spirit-empowered ministry to children from nursery through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. To help children understand and embrace God's love for them, come to know Jesus Christ as Savior and give children opportunities to be filled and used by the Holy Spirit. To provide a safe learning environment where children can grow in every aspect of their walk with Jesus, as well as in their physical and emotional development. To work with families to grow in relationship with each other and with Jesus Christ becoming healthier and stronger together. To connect children to their part in the Great Commission and to serving others.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. Must have a calling to career ministry and, if married, spouse must support this call.
2. Must be baptized in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues.
3. Must be licensed with the Assemblies of God or must complete the process within one year of joining our team.
4. Must be in agreement with the tenets of faith as outlined by the General Council.
5. Must be in agreement with the purpose, mission and policies of Victory Road Assembly of God..

### **OVERVIEW OF RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Presents a well-balanced, Christ-centered ministry to children – making consistent opportunities to receive Jesus as Savior.
2. Helps children become disciples – helping them to understand that Jesus wants to use them now and that He has a place for them in ministry to others as they grow.
3. Emphasizes the importance of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, with the initial evidence of speaking in other tongues, for holiness and empowerment for service to Jesus Christ. Must provide ample opportunity for children to experience the Holy Spirit and be filled and used by Him.
4. Responsible for children's Christian education taught throughout the week and any in-house seminars or classes dealing with children and families.
5. Works with parents to promote and maintain spiritual harmony within the family, community and church.
6. Responsible to provide special times of ministry to the church body by the children; to supervise, plan, coordinate, and execute activities that pertain to those services, activities and ministries.
7. Organizes and oversees worker recruiting and training, including for Camps in the summer.
8. Responsible for budgeting, financial accountability and goal setting for Boys & Girls Missionary Challenge.
9. Organizes registration, worker recruiting and transportation for all camps, including Youth Camp if needed.
10. Must be willing to accept additional duties as assigned by the Lead Pastor.
